'Translation, education and pragmatics' (TEP II) postgraduate symposium

The symposium intends to encourage postgraduate collaboration, exchange of innovation and creative ideas in the field of translation studies, among (neighbouring, for the time being) universities, and aspires to expand its potential and geographical scope to include more universities and postgraduate programmes in the future.

The collaboration started as an exchange of talks at shared postgraduate sessions of the four universities, intended to balance the isolation following the second wave of the pandemic (Fall 2020), but the organizers soon realized that there is more to this collaboration and thought of advancing it by organizing a postgraduate symposium on translation, education and pragmatics, their interconnection and interdisciplinary potential. Both Education and Pragmatics have important insights to offer to Translation Studies and translations studies can vigorously return the favour by opening up a new platform and resource material for both education and pragmatics. The postgraduate Symposium intends to explore a potential overlap of these disciplines.
